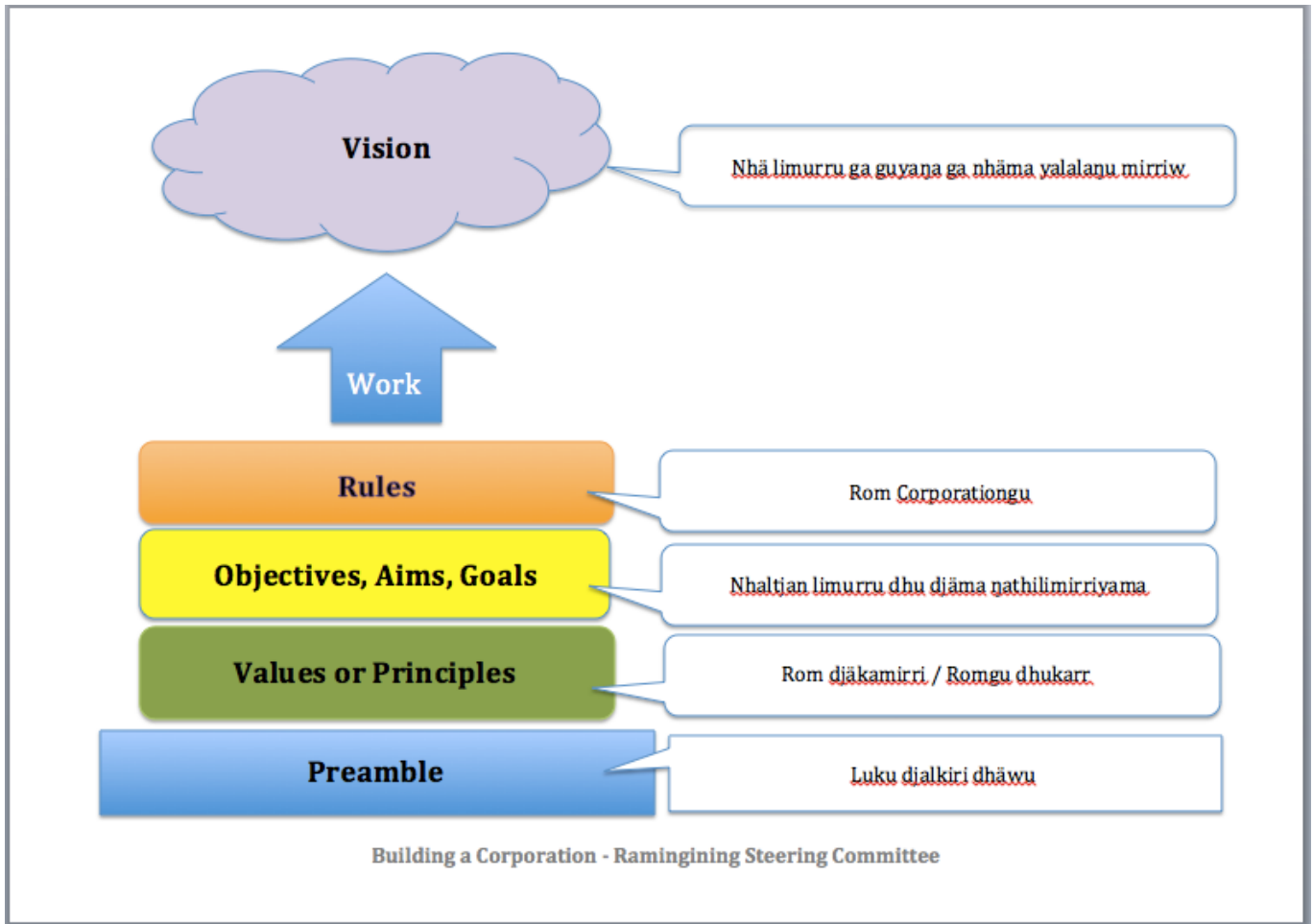

We used this diagram and a larger version on the floor.



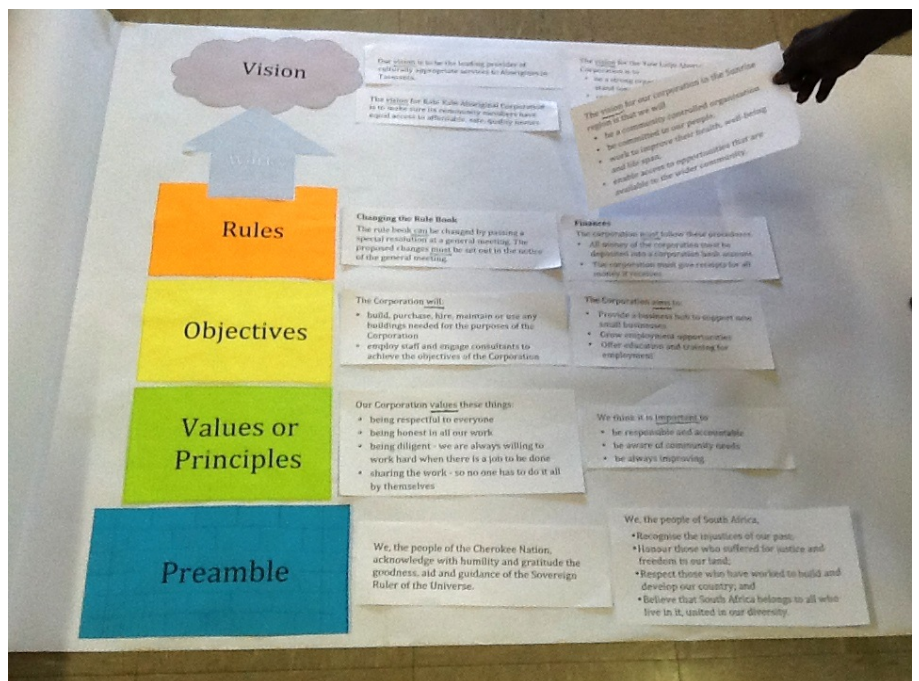
We wrote the meanings on the glossary and we practised sorting statements from different Corporations into the five groups.
